





### SPECIFICATIONS



**Diluent Syringe** (For use with pumps with valves) Designed for use with the TriContinent valve, the polycarbonate valve has luer fittings, one male and one female. One fitting is positioned upward and is typically used for liquid output for ease of priming.



**Dual Port Syringe** (For use with pumps without valves) Designed for use as the sampling syringe on a dual-syringe diluter set-up. The adapter is a "T" with the output positioned upward, for priming consideration. This syringe utilizes male luer fittings.



**Single Port Syringe** (For use with pumps without valves) This syringe has a single 1/4-28 female port positioned at the top of the adapter. It is ideal for use with external, customer provided valves. It is also ideal for air displacement applications.

### How to Select the Correct Syringe Size

Selecting the correct syringe for any particular application is largely a matter of experimentation, however, there is one rule of thumb that should never be ignored. Use the largest syringe capable of giving acceptable results with your smallest desired volume.
